WHAT'S ON OFFER?

We are offering two levels of qualifications, so there is something for everyone:

CERTIFICATE OF ACHIEVEMENT PART I - OPEN TO MEMBERS AND NON-MEMBERS

Perfect for new learners with little experience of studying. It has been designed to help you develop your study skills and build your confidence.

Core and Optional modules include:

- Professional roles and responsibilities
- Communication skills
- Team working

- Health & safety
- Sample handling
- Performing standard tests

Once you've successfully completed the portfolio you will be eligible to apply to the IBMS to become a Registered Science Technician (RSciTech), provided you have joined the IBMS as an Associate member.

CERTIFICATE OF ACHIEVEMENT PART II - MEMBER ONLY

This qualification has been designed for those with more responsibility. In addition to the core modules you can choose from a range of optional modules, tailoring the qualification to your needs.

In addition to the key areas in Part I, modules in Part II include:

- Developing others
- Planning and monitoring work
- Investigating specimens at a microscopic level
- Use of automated analyser
- Staining specimens
- Point-of-care testing

Once you've successfully completed the portfolio you will be eligible to apply to the IBMS for registration as a Registered Scientist (RSci).

Study materials

Fees

These qualifications aim to demonstrate the knowledge and skills applicable to the role of biomedical support staff within laboratories.

Who can apply?

Part I - This is available to all individuals and there are no academic entry requirements. It is designed for people who do not have qualifications at the level traditionally required for university entry. You do not need to be an IBMS member to apply.

Part II – You must be a member of the Institute of Biomedical Science working in a support role to access Part II. And either have Part I or another comparable qualification such as an NVQ/SVQ 3.

Note: Applicants for Part II must have completed Part I or provide evidence of relevant Level 3 (Scotland Level 5) qualifications e.g. Biology 'A' Level certificate and a statement outlining scope of practice for evaluation.
