



IBMS Data Use and Privacy Notice Declaration for Verifiers and Examiners

As an Information Commissioners Office registered Data Controller, the IBMS is required to comply with legal regulations to protect the Personal Data of users of its services and management of data to safeguard Data Subjects interests.

The IBMS has consent from IBMS qualification trainees, training officers and laboratory managers to share Personal Data specific to verification or examination visits to assess trainees and their places of training.

Personal Data received by verifiers and examiners from the IBMS for the purpose of a verification and examination must only be used for the purpose of and specific to the verification and examination visit.

It should be noted that Data Protection regulations require that the IBMS investigates and gives consideration where a Data Subject implies that Personal Data has been used without the express permission of the Data Subject.
